

# Admit from ED to MICU, NCCU, or RICU

This tip sheet explains how to write the Admit from ED order when admitting to these specific units ONLY:

- MICU
- NCCU
- RICU

For all other admissions, continue to use the current workflow: both the Admitting & Attending Provider section should be filled in with the name of the attending from the floor or ICU who will be accepting the patient.



## Try It Out-new workflow for the above ICUs ONLY

1. When admitting to one of the units above, the Admit from ED order should list the Admitting Provider (accepting ICU attending) as the Admitting physician.
2. The Attending Provider should be the ED Attending.
