Admit from ED to MICU, NCCU, or RICU

This tip sheet explains how to write the Admit from ED order when admitting to these specific units ONLY:

- MICU
- NCCU
- RICU

For all other admissions, continue to use the current workflow: both the Admitting & Attending Provider section should be filled in with the name of the attending from the floor or ICU who will be accepting the patient.



- 1. When admitting to one of the units above, the Admit from ED order should list the Admitting Provider (accepting ICU attending) as the Admitting physician.
- 2. The Attending Provider should be the ED Attending.
