

Important Information for Rabies Treatment

Your treatment for rabies has been started today. Three additional vaccinations (in roughly 3, 7 and 14 days from today's visit) are required to complete your treatment. To account for weekends, the chart below has been created to guide scheduling these vaccinations. If your second dose will be due on a "holiday" when the follow up clinic is closed, please discuss with the treating physician how to account for this.

Sunday	Wednesday	Monday	Monday

For example: if your first vaccination was given on a Tuesday, your next vaccination should be scheduled on Friday.

If you are an adult and have received your initial vaccination / treatment at Rhode Island Hospital or The Miriam Hospital emergency department, additional doses of vaccine will be administered at The Miriam Hospital's Infectious Diseases Clinic located at 180 Corliss Street 3rd Floor Suite E, Providence RI 02904. Please call 793-2928 to schedule your next appointment for additional vaccinations.

If you are a child and have received your initial treatment at either Hasbro or Miriam Emergency Department, please call the Hasbro Children's Hospital Clinic, Hasbro Hospital Lower Level, 593 Eddy St Providence RI. Please call 444-4762 to schedule your next appointment for additional vaccinations.

If multiple members of a family have been treated for possible rabies AND family members include children < 18 years old and adults > 18 years old, additional vaccinations will be administered to both the adults and children at the Hasbro Children's Hospital Clinic, Hasbro Hospital Lower Level, 593 Eddy St Providence RI.
