Other Things to Know

D Pod: It is a big win to try and see patients upstairs in **A Triage** instead of chasing them down in D Pod. This will only work if we see them fast as they will need to move downstairs ASAP for safety reasons (and may be moved if we are too slow in seeing them). These patients should be shared between you, the attendings and senior residents.

- Care of patients in D Pod should transition to you only after initial results are back and psych as been contacted if needed or if the other provider is signing out
 - Rarely for safety reasons a patient may need to move downstairs without evaluation in A Triage. If this occurs please see the patient in D Pod.
- If C Pod is boarding you can also present to the C Pod Attending who will be working in A Pod
