## Other Things to Know

Patients will typically flow to B Pod through PIT. In rare situations where there are open beds on B Pod and a delay in PIT it may make sense to flow some patients directly to B Pod to be seen by you primarily. If you notice this happening please work with the triage techs to select the easiest sounding ESI 4s and 5s to pull back.

- You are the best judge of who will be an appropriate patient so help them choose.
