Other Things to Know

- If boarding is high C Pod will be used as a holding unit and providers sent to help the active pods
- If boarding in C Pod on arrival: Flex to B Pod, assist the team in vertical
 - If unit re-opens you should only flex back if there are >8 active beds (otherwise attending alone can manage)
