

C APP: 7a-4p shift (Feb Only)

Other Things to Know

- If boarding is high C Pod will be used as a holding unit and providers sent to help the active pods
- If boarding in C Pod: At 7am you flex to B Pod, replace the B/A APP, take signout from the B Pod overnight team and work in vertical.
 - This allows the B/A APP to start in A Pod at 7am
 - If unit re-opens you should only flex back if there are >8 active beds (otherwise attending alone can manage)
