Other Things to Know

The key of this shift is that at 11pm you should do a group sign-out with the outgoing doc, the outgoing APP and the 4p-1a APP (the overnight team takes no sign-out at 11pm) in B Pod. The goal is to divide and concur dispo with the APP - the APP should not assume care of entire B Pod - you should split patients. If you have plenty of bandwidth you can return to PIT for a little but by midnight you should be back in B pod for the rest of your shift clearing people out until you sign out at 2am. This should result in a better sign-out for the overnight doc and get you out on time.
