Other Things to Know

- You will start seeing patients in PIT and follow them through B Pod until disposition. Expect to see a higher volume of lower acuity patients.
 - Learn from attending on Vert vs. Prime decisions:
 - If Prime - don't sign up, write triage note (send to attending for cosign), place initial orders
 - If Vert - Sign up, write full note, place all orders
- Shift is designed to be more PIT for the first half
 - On arrival expect B pod to be full. Most patients you see will go back to waiting room until space opens
 - After several hours, your first patients will have beds/results
 - Gradually spend more time in B pod as patients flow back
 - Consider pulling procedures directly to a procedure room or doing in PIT
- Will attempt to staff nurse in PIT until 3a but if not possible please communicate with public triage RN and Charge RN for urgent needs
