

Young Adult (< 22 YO) Admissions to Hasbro

- All young adult patients under 22 years old should be admitted to the appropriate pediatric service at Hasbro except:
 - Behavioral Health (18 and older)
 - Trauma (18 and older)
 - Patients followed by an adult specialty at RIH
 - 18-21 yo CDU-appropriate patients should still be admitted to the RIH ED CDU

RIH ED to Hasbro Pediatric Admitting Algorithm

- If Patient requires ICU/Stepdown Care (or unsure if they do):
 - ED Attending must call PICU Attending (call PICU secretary at 4-8351)
 - If accepted have ED resident call PICU resident for signout
 - ED Team continues to manage until departure (same as adult ICU)
 - “Stepdown” patients still go to PICU – PICU Attending will determine
- Patient with surgical issue (General, Ortho, Neurosurgery, ENT)
 - Page the covering resident – Pedi General Surgery has own resident
 - Ortho, Neurosurgery and ENT are same resident as adult consults – will staff with PEDI attending as appropriate
- Pediatric medicine admits go to the Pediatric Hospitalist Service
 - Page the admitting resident for all admissions 350-1700
 - Certain pediatric specialty services will sometimes admit, in these cases you still need to call the pediatric admitting resident after speaking to the covering fellow/attending. These services include
 - Endocrine (call for DKA), GI, Heme/Onc, Neurology, Adolescent (eating disorders)
 - If unsure – start with Pedi Admitting Resident for guidance
- When patient accepted you must ask for both attending and responding provider
 - Place the bed request as usual – add the responding provider to the patient’s care team
 - PEDI Floor Admits are managed by ED until 2-hours after bed request (this is different than adult)
 - Please order any time critical meds needing during that time
- Send a secure chat to patient’s ED Nurse and the Responding Provider noting the time that care will change to the inpatient team
